### **Meeting commenced at 7:04pm**

#### **1. Approval of Agenda**

- Approved. Bruce first, Paul second.

#### **2. Approval of Previous Minutes**

- Approved. Sherri first, Melanie second.

#### **3. Competition Development Course Update**

- Comp Dev course scheduled for April 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> likely cancelled- to be rescheduled.
- Approved by Archery Canada to go through with course, however issues arose.
- Course was to be overseen remotely by Bruce Savage, and instructed by Duncan Crawford.
- Member of AANS expressed concern and voiced opinion which led to complications surrounding course in Nova Scotia. The situation was handled unprofessionally.
- Bruce and Melanie suggest Jason connects with member of AANS to address the situation and look for diplomatic solutions. Jason agrees to contact AANS member.
- Confirmed with Gayle Marchand that course with Duncan and Bruce Savage was approved.

It is suggested that the course is postponed and re-evaluated.

#### **4. 3D Provincials Hosting Manual**

- Issues around cheating at the Bruce Scott shoot.
- Difficult to address at a club level.
- Paul suggests that the AANS 3D Provincials be a registered shoot with AC.
- Sherri to create a manual, then send to the Board and then membership.
- Board approves that a 3D Provincials Hosting Manual be created.

#### **5. Support4Sport Awards**

- 2 male nominees: Austin Ellis, Matt MacDonald. Austin voted as winner by board.
- 1 female nominee: Sherri Robicheau. Agreed upon by board.
- 1 official nominee: Ken Saulnier. Agreed upon by board.
- 1 volunteer nominee: Chap Harpell. Agreed upon by board.
- 1 sponsor nominee: Leaves & Limbs. Agreed upon by board.
- AANS to pay for each winner's ticket.

#### **6. 2018 Nationals Update**

- Paul met with Chad after the Judges course
- Chad requested information from Trina Snooks about Judges
- Updated hosting manual on Archery Canada website
- Budgets sent by Archery Canada, reviewed by Paul
- Jason suggests contact Renee Scheub for reference

#### **7. 2017 PSO Outcome Report**

- Ryan to put report on a Google Document and send to the board for them to complete.
- Must be submitted by April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

#### **8. New Business Arising**

- Signing authorities complete. Melanie, Nicole, Paul S, Paul R have signing authority.
- Paul attended the NSAF AGM , a hat was given by the organization to give to a member within AANS.

- Some outstanding cheques are out. Need to be taken care of.
- A box of CanBow badges were found at Osprey Archery Club. Jason makes note that AC may be revamping the program and suggests we hold on action.
- A need for 720 shoots leading up to Nationals. Bruce notes Osprey would be willing to host several shoots. AANS has until June to register shoots with AC without penalty.
- 5 registered shoots necessary for athletes to be ranked nationally. A minimum of 3 registered shoots in required for the NSPPI.
- Bruce to speak with Osprey to get dates for potential 720 shoots.
