ANS Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

July 30th, 2020 | 8pm

Meeting called to order by Melanie Lefler at 8:08pm.

1. Approval of Previous Minutes
 - Roy motions to approve the minutes from July 14th, 2020. Seconded by Ray. Motion carried unopposed.
2. Shoot Schedule (Member only vs. Open to local members)
 - First shoot on the schedule come August 1st is Northumberland/St. Mary's; this would be a regular club shoot, not Provincials.
 - Ray motions to have the shoot schedule go ahead as normal come August 1st. Seconded by Roy. Motion carried unopposed.
3. 3D Indoor Championship Bids
 - Atlantic region is the primary choice to host the 2022 Indoor Championships. Archery NS has received 2 offers for hosting. Bid is open until November 2020.
 - The two bids in question are looking for a date that they can work with so they can start looking to put together a tentative proposal before deadline. Tournament dates are normally end of March to Mid-April in 2022.

Action: Melanie to touch base with two parties who placed bid to discuss timelines.

4. NASP Update
 - Don notes that he is working with Nick at Sport NS to create the student scholarship fund. NASP may not be able to match scholarship funds due to COVID.
 - Looking for a school to host NASP provincials; have touched base with a teacher in Sackville and is waiting to hear back.

- Don attended a 2 day NASP Zoom conference. One thing to note from conference is that ANS will get a prize cheque to be deposited into the NASP account for scholarships.
5. Sackville Sport Stadium Archery Program
- The Sackville Sport Stadium Archery Program is looking for a coach to run it; was suggested to reach out to ANS regarding a potential coach/supports for the program. Hoping the position can be filled with any of our own coaches.
6. Shoot Schedule Additions
- The shoot schedule is updated thus far as follows:
 - i. August 9th: Northumberland/St. Mary's hosting club shoot (not Provincials as this isn't a registered shoot)
 - ii. August 16th: Musquodoboit shoot (Annapolis East cancellation date)
 - iii. August 23rd: Glooscap shoot
 - iv. August 30th: Millbrook shoot
 - v. September 5-6th: Cape Breton Francis Shebib shoot (cancelled?)
 - vi. September 27th: Fundy Shore shoot request
 - Roy motions to accept the three changes/additions to shoot schedule. Seconded by Don. Motion carried unopposed.

Action: Melanie to reach out to Cape Breton Bowmen directly about the status of the Francis Shebib shoot.

Action: Emily to update these changes to website/shoot schedule.

7. 2021 Shoot Schedule Meeting
- August 15th was originally the date for the 2021 shoot schedule meeting. Not able to have it face to face; will be virtual. Discussion on changing the time/date as some cannot make the 15th.

Action: Emily to send out Doodle Poll to clubs regarding a time for meeting in the evening on a weekday on either the week of August 10-14 or August 17-21.

8. New Business
- COVID Package
 - i. Looking into prices on what it would cost to have signage printed and laminated to be given to clubs (from Sport NS Print Shop). COVID club package would include: Paper copy of updated shoot schedule, updated R2P plan, masks, and sanitizer to purchase. Whatever clubs need to safely open.
 - ii. Government is supplying small businesses/sports masks for free but they are getting harder to acquire.
 - iii. Idea of ordering supplies through ANS instead of having the clubs purchase them separately.
