### **ANS Board of Directors Meeting Minutes**

**Meeting called to order by Melanie Lefler at 8:03pm.**

- Approval of Previous Minutes
  - o Roy motions to approve the minutes from September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Seconded by Sherri. Motion carried unopposed.
  
- ASA Shoots
  - o Archery Canada stated that they would like to have 3-4 ASA style shoots per year per Province. Looking to cascade this information to clubs either before or at our 2020 AGM.
    - Targets are slightly different but there is a low cost-option to turn them into the correct target style for ASA shoots. ASA shooting rules are under the American Shooting Association.

**Action: Melanie to follow-up to get ASA shoot rules and cascade to the Board.**

- Sport Nova Scotia Locker
  - o Discussion via email regarding an opportunity to move from our current storage space, Apple Storage, to a locker at Sport NS. Our current storage space requires 2-weeks notice minimum to cancel locker with them. We would have 24/7 access to the SNS locker and it is rented at a monthly cost (\$80.5 per-month). Savings of around \$700 per year to move to this new locker.
  - o Paul motions to move Archery Nova Scotia's storage space from Apple Storage to the new locker at Sport Nova Scotia. Seconded by Roy. Motion carried unopposed.
  
- Return to Competition Plan

- Plan is almost finalized; we've received verbal approval from the province that we have appropriate protocols in place that we can accommodate return to play for members and non-members (covers try-it events and competitions).
- There is ongoing development on when it's appropriate to wear masks and obtaining clear guidelines around this. CCH provided verbal approval that we can go-ahead with this but we need to have something in writing to distribute to clubs and our members. This updated paper copy is almost finalized.
- A few clubs have reached out regarding the status on shooting (indoors especially).
  
- **AGM**
  - Notice for the AGM and the request for club/board reports was distributed 30 days in advance.
  
- **Financial Report**
  - Don notes that financially we're in pretty good shape; we have a bit more income come in than what our expenses were. Still need to finalize a few more reports prior to the AGM. Don and Melanie to finalize this report. Will be sent in advance to the Board for review.
  
- **Bid Process**
  - There is one bid with an upcoming deadline (November 7) for the 2022 Pan-Ams. Hosting National/International events would be great exposure for the sport in the Atlantic Provinces/NS specifically.
